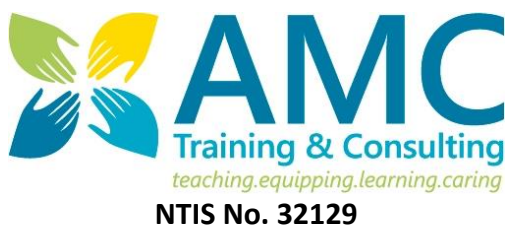
This course is delivered by correspondence. This course combines work from home modules (Booklets) and assessment in the workplace.

- scope of practice, the legalities of medication
- policies and procedures
- infection control basics, medication basics
- side effects vs adverse drug reactors
- common problems with medication use in older people, medication errors and incidences
- documentation, terms and abbreviations
- how do medications work in the body
- routes of administration
- assisting clients with medications
- environmental hazards relating to medications
