Qualification Description:

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE PROGRAM

Am I eligible? Are you:

- An Australian citizen or Australian permanent resident residing in QLD or a New Zealand citizen permanently residing in QLD?
- Not currently enrolled in nor hold a post-school Certificate III or higher level qualification?
- 15 years of age or older?
- No longer at school?
- If you answered yes to all of the above you are eligible for the Certificate 3 Guarantee Program.

Concession or Non-Concession?

To be eligible for a Concession you must hold a Health Care/Pensioner Card or be a partner/dependant of a person who holds a Health Care/Pensioner Card (you must be named on the card) or you an ATSI person.

Course Delivery:

This course is delivered by correspondence. This course combines work from online modules, and workplace assessments from a direct supervisor.

If you have undertaken formal studies or have achieved competence through workplace or other training, you can apply for recognition of prior learning (RPL) via the enrolment form (fees apply). Direct credit transfer of a module already completed does not cost anything.



Student Support:

All students are supported according to their individual needs and there will be no discrimination against students on any grounds. We ask you to raise any concerns with us. AMC Training Comments and Complaints process will be followed.

Work Placement:

Due to current COVID-19 restrictions on students within facilities, you MUST be currently employed within the care industry in a role relative to the qualification. You must confirm that you are employed and you can provide payslips to show this.

Your employment should cover the full range of experiences required to cover all modules of study. If any workplace assessments are required, we will contact a supervisor for a third-party report. If they are unable to provide this, someone with a "work place trainer and assessor" qualification will have to assess your competency relative to the module criteria.

Course Breakdown:

There are 13 units in the Certificate III in Individual Support consisting of 7 core and 6 elective units. Specialisation:

- All Group A electives must be selected for award of the Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing).
- All Group B electives must be selected for award of the Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability).
- At least four units from Group C electives must be selected for award of the *Certificate III in Individual Support (Home and Community)*.
- Where two specialisations are completed award of the qualification would read Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community)

Notes about course costs:

Remaining payment due either:
